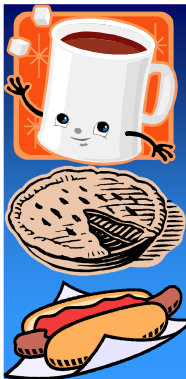

Some of the Vets have other roles such as Coaching, Managing, First Aid Officer, Results Updates etc to fulfill on the day so we need all of you to help. If you are only able to attend for a couple of hours at some time during the day please do so as it will help. We will also need help in the canteen on Saturday afternoon after your game restocking the fridges, cutting up salad for the next day, etc.

On the day we will be selling Pies, Sausage Rolls, Hot Dogs, Soup, Salad Rolls, Tubs of Fruit Salad but no toasted sandwiches. The ice-cream fridge will be outside the canteen and will need someone to stay with it. Also the tea & coffee will be sold outside at the back of the BBQ area. Varroville Club has been asked to man this. The Krispy Kreme donuts will also be sold from there.

We will need people from 6am to make up 300 salad rolls and wraps as well. At the same time people will be needed to butter finger buns. The BBQ near the canteen will be run by all the junior rep team parents while the BBQ on the bottom fields is to be run by the State League & Opens team players. These are supposed to be operating by 7am to sell Egg & Bacon Rolls to the travelers as they arrive.

Remember there are many jobs for the day and any time you can spare would be appreciated. It is hoped that we will raise the bulk of our funds for the trip to Wagga on that day.
